CONCLUSION OF THE ENDOWMENT FUND (2012–2026)

Closing Concert of the Villa des Compositeurs
Salle André Marchal – INJA, Paris 26 November 2025, 7:30 pm

The Villa des Compositeurs marked the closure of its endowment fund with a Closing Concert held at the Salle André Marchal of the Institut National des Jeunes Aveugles (INJA) in Paris.

This event celebrated more than thirteen years of artistic life, creation, and transmission. Conceived as a concert of gratitude, it paid tribute to the donors, artists, and partners who have supported the Villa since its foundation in 2012.

The evening brought together:

- a violin and piano duo — Collection “Create and Transmit” — featuring Romeo and Juliet, violin concerto by Christophe Guyard (world premiere), and Sonata Op.18 by Jean Della Valle;
- the Lucrèce Collection Trio, an Homage to the French Prix de Rome, with works by André Caplet, Alexandre Bénéteau, Roger Boutry, Anthony Girard, Jean-Dominique Krynen, Marc Lys, Gabriel Malancioiu, and Giacomo Platini;
- and a final quartet — Collection “Molière” — performing Second Drinking Song by Marc Lys, uniting all performers in a joyful close.

This concert marked the official conclusion of the Villa’s activities as an endowment fund, while affirming the enduring vitality of its artistic vision. Though the legal structure of the Villa des Compositeurs will reach its term in 2026, its spirit of creation, transmission and friendship may one day find new forms and initiatives beyond this chapter.
